WHAT DO WE MEAN BY "DIGITAL RIGHTS"? THIS SESSION AIMS TO EXPLAIN THAT DIGITAL RIGHTS ARE HUMAN RIGHTS, I.E. THAT THE SAME HUMAN RIGHTS THAT APPLY OFFLINE, ALSO APPLY ONLINE. THE INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS FRAMEWORKS THAT FORM THE FOUNDATION OF WHAT WE MEAN BY "DIGITAL RIGHTS", AS WELL AS DIGITAL RIGHTS PRINCIPLES EMBRACED BY THE ONLINE COMMUNITY SUCH AS EQUAL ACCESS, THE RIGHT TO NON-DISCRIMINATION, FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION, ACCESS TO INFORMATION, DATA PROTECTION/PRIVACY, SECURITY, AND RIGHT TO REMEDY, WILL ALSO BE EXPLAINED.

MOST PEOPLE ARE NOT AWARE OF THE COMPLEX PROCESSES BEHIND SOCIAL MEDIA ALGORITHMS, SEARCH ENGINES, WEBSITE COOKIES AND TRACKERS AND SO ON. DURING THIS WORKSHOP, THE PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THE PRACTICAL IMPLICATIONS OF DIGITAL RIGHTS AND HOW TO BE MORE AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL RISKS.

DIGITAL PLATFORMS HAVE GROWN TO BECOME GIANT CENTRALISED SYSTEMS GOVERNING NOT ONLY OUR PERSONAL DATA, BUT OUR BELIEFS, NEEDS AND INTERESTS TO A LARGER EXTENT. IN THAT SENSE, WE AS USERS ARE NOT ONLY THE "RAW RESOURCE" USED FOR DATA AND KNOWLEDGE EXTRACTION - WE ARE ALSO LABORERS IN THESE CLOSED AND NON-TRANSPARENT SYSTEMS. THE PROCESSES OF COLLECTING, STORING AND ANALYSING AS MUCH INFORMATION ON HUMANS AS POSSIBLE HAVE A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON NUMEROUS SOCIAL PROCESSES, SUCH AS ELECTIONS, PROTESTS OR RECENTLY WARS. THIS SESSION AIMS TO PROVIDE PARTICIPANTS WITH A BETTER INSIGHT INTO THE IMPACT OF TECHNOLOGY AND WHAT CAN BE DONE TO REDUCE THE HARMS.

DATA PROTECTION IS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF DIGITAL RIGHTS, ESPECIALLY SINCE THE GDPR WAS INTRODUCED. THE SESSIONS AIM TO REVIEW THE LANDSCAPE OF INTERNATIONAL AND REGIONAL (EU) LEGAL FRAMEWORKS PROTECTING THE RIGHT TO PRIVACY. WE WILL EXPLORE ATTEMPTS TO HARMONISE PRIVACY REGULATIONS ACROSS THE EU WITH THE GDPR AND E-PRIVACY DIRECTIVE, AND HOW THE EUROPEAN APPROACH TO PRIVACY DIVERGES RADICALLY FROM THAT OF THE U.S., WHERE MANY GLOBAL SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS ARE HEADQUARTERED.

PERSONAL DATA ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT RESOURCE OF THE DIGITAL ECONOMY AND THE LIFEBLOOD OF BIG TECH COMPANIES, SUCH AS GOOGLE, META OR MICROSOFT AMONG OTHERS. HOWEVER, CITIZENS AS DATA SUBJECTS ARE NOT POWERLESS - DATA PROTECTION LAW GIVES THEM NUMEROUS RIGHTS TO HAVE CONTROL OVER THEIR DATA, SUCH AS ACCESS, DELETION OR PORTABILITY, AS WELL AS THE RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT WITH THEIR COUNTRY'S DATA PROTECTION AUTHORITY. DURING THIS SESSION THE PARTICIPANTS WILL LEARN THE IMPORTANCE OF EXERCISING THEIR PERSONAL DATA RIGHTS AND HOW USE THESE MECHANISMS IN PRACTICE.

THE AIM OF THE WORKSHOP IS TO EXPLAIN WHAT ARE THE KEY ELEMENTS OF A SUCCESSFUL ADVOCACY EFFORT OR A CAMPAIGN, HOW TO BEST USE AND MANAGE RESOURCES AND HAVE A SOCIAL IMPACT BEYOND JUST THE CLOSEST COMMUNITY MEMBERS.

OF ONLINE CONTENT

BOJANA KOSTIĆ

DIGITAL PLATFORMS TODAY HAVE IMMENSE POWER TO SHAPE CONTENT, NEWS, AND INFORMATION WE SEE AND SHARE ONLINE. THIS SESSION WILL EXPLAIN HOW PLATFORMS HAVE DEVELOPED AND DEPLOYED DIFFERENT TYPES OF AUTOMATED SYSTEMS/AI TO HELP POLICE A IMMENSE AMOUNTS OF USER-GENERATED CONTENT THAT VIOLATES THE LAW OR THAT RUNS AFOUL OF COMPANIES' OWN POLICIES. IT IS ALSO IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT THESE SYSTEMS OFTEN MIS-IDENTIFY AND REMOVE LEGITIMATE CONTENT WHILE FAILING TO ACCURATELY OR CONSISTENTLY SPOT HARMFUL, ABUSIVE, OR ILLEGAL CONTENT, IN WHICH CASE THESE MATERIALS CONTINUE TO PROLIFERATE ONLINE.

FROM LAWS BANNING FAKE NEWS TO REGULATIONS REQUIRING PLATFORMS TO RAPIDLY REMOVE HARMFUL CONTENT, GOVERNMENTS ALL OVER THE WORLD ARE PASSING LAWS AND REGULATIONS RESTRICTING WHAT TYPES OF CONTENT CAN BE VIEWED AND SHARED ONLINE. THIS SESSION WILL PROVIDE INSIGHT INTO THE WORRISOME DETERIORATION OF ONLINE FREE EXPRESSION NORMS AND PRACTICES, AS POLICYMAKERS ADAPT TO MORE AUTHORITARIAN APPROACHES TO CENSORSHIP AND STATE ACTORS GRAPPLE WITH WAYS TO HOLD TECH COMPANIES ACCOUNTABLE FOR THE PROLIFERATION OF HARMFUL CONTENT ONLINE.

THE INTERNET IS FILLED WITH BLOGS, MEMES, VIDEOS AND OTHER FORMS OF CONTENT WHICH MAY NOT BE ILLEGAL BUT CAN CAUSE PERSONAL DISTRESS AND SOCIAL DIVISION, AND IN SOME CASES HAVE REAL-LIFE CONSEQUENCES. THIS SESSION WILL PROVIDE MORE INSIGHT INTO WHAT ARE THE ASPECTS OF PROBLEMATIC ONLINE SPEECH AND HOW TO AVOID OVER-REGULATING MATTERS RELATED TO USER-GENERATED CONTENT POSTED TO ONLINE PLATFORMS.

DATA-DRIVEN POLICING
AND MARGINALISED
COMMUNITIES

SANNE STEVENS

THERE IS GROWING EVIDENCE THAT THE USE OF DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES HAS THE POTENTIAL NOT ONLY TO REPRODUCE BUT ALSO TO AMPLIFY EXISTING FORMS OF INEQUALITY AND OPPRESSION, SUCH AS RACISM AND DISCRIMINATION. RECENTLY, SEVERAL ACTORS WITHIN THE DIGITAL RIGHTS-FIELD REALISED THAT THIS HAS BEEN AN IGNORED DYNAMIC AND A BLIND-SPOT IN MANY DIGITAL RIGHTS DEBATES. THIS SESSION FIRST SETS THE STAGE BY INVESTIGATING HOW THE USE OF SURVEILLANCE AND OTHER DATA-DRIVEN TECHNOLOGIES BY GOVERNMENTS INCREASES INEQUALITY AND CONTRIBUTES TO DISCRIMINATORY PRACTISES. DISCUSSING CONCRETE CASES OF DATA-DRIVEN TARGETING OF MIGRANTS, ROMA AND RACIALISED COMMUNITIES, WE WILL THEN DISCUSS WHICH STRATEGIES THE DIGITAL RIGHTSFIELD COULD ADOPT TO ADDRESS THE DISPROPORTIONATE EFFECTS OF DATA-DRIVEN TECHNOLOGIES ON MARGINALISED COMMUNITIES AND WHO ARE THE IMPORTANT ACTORS FOR STRATEGIC COLLABORATION.

OVER THE YEARS, CIVIL SOCIETY AND ADVOCACY GROUPS HAVE DEVELOPED DIFFERENT TACTICS IN TERMS OF PROTECTION OF DIGITAL RIGHTS. THIS SESSION WILL PROVIDE MORE INFORMATION ON THE APPROACH OF STRATEGIC LITIGATION, I.E. INITIATING COURT PROCESSES IN MATTERS OF STRATEGIC IMPORTANCE TO DEFEND AND UPHOLD DIGITAL RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS, AS IT HAS PROVEN TO BE AN EFFECTIVE WAY OF HOLDING BOTH GOVERNMENTS AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS AND VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS.
