


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This document provides an overview of important logistical information to help you prepare for our Retreat. Please read it carefully before you travel, as there are a number of things worth considering when you are packing your bags.

THE VIEW FROM THE VENUE



What is the address for the venue?

Ancient St. Antun Monastery near Jadranska Magistrala (E6/E20),
Perast 85336, Montenegro (Lat 42.48647; Lon 18.69986)

You can find it via this [link](#) on Google Maps or if you Google **Old Catholic Monastery in Perast, Montenegro**.

It is worth noting that the Monastery is a UNESCO world heritage site. In fact, the entire village is – and it is often listed as one of the most beautiful and unusual small places [worth visiting in Europe](#). It is special – and it has been like this for centuries, and we want to make a good impression on its inhabitants and respect their way of living.

Due to the unique location of the Monastery, we prepared a photo to give you an idea of the location of the Monastery (the Monastery is indicated by the white circle).



How will I get from the airport to the venue?

If you arrive in Tivat, we suggest that you take [Red Taxi Kotor](#). You should show the exact [location](#) to Taxi driver so he can leave you at closes point to the Monastery. The drive from Tivat airport will take approx. 45 minutes, the drive from Podgorica Airport will take approx. 2.5 hours, and the drive from Dubrovnik Airport to Perast will take approx. 2.5 hours (all depending on traffic, of course, since it is going to be 'high season').

As previously explained due to the specific location of the Monastery, the taxi driver will drop you off by the side of the road. From there, take the tunnel below the road, next to the small parking lot where you were dropped off, and walk the 60m down the stairs, as shown in the photo on the next page. Make sure to have a photo with you to show to the taxi driver.

At the end of the first set of stairs, on your right side you will see a green metal door, i.e. the entrance to the **Monastery of St. Antun**.



Travel Insurance

The medical services for foreigners in Montenegro can be costly, so we highly recommend that you obtain travel insurance in your country of residence.

Shared Rooms - Who will I be sharing a room with?

The capacity of the Monastery is very limited and most bedrooms will have two beds, while some have three. This means you may be sharing a bedroom with one other person, unless you indicate a strong preference against sharing a room. It should be fun after all! So we exchange minor discomforts for the pleasure of getting to know our peers!

What will the weather be like there?

The temperature should be between 25°C and 35°C.

So the weather will be nice!

What should I bring?

Obviously pack whatever you need for a week-long trip in a warm climate, but there are a number of items that you should really remember to bring:

- ~~~~ Your devices (laptop, phone) (please remember to insure these items and any other valuables);
- ~~~~ Beach towels & additional bathroom towels;
- ~~~~ Toothbrush, toothpaste and other toiletries necessary (the Monastery is not a hotel, so do not expect the usual freebies you find in hotel rooms!);

- 🌊 Mosquito repellent (you will regret it if you do not bring this!);
- 🌊 Sunscreen, swimming costume, beach stuff and diving goggles if needed (or any other equipment you like);
- 🌊 Any medicine you need;
- 🌊 Plug adapter (Montenegro uses power sockets type F like most of Europe, plug C and E also work)

- 🌊 Materials from your organisation or community that you want to share with others

What language will the event be in?

The entire event will be held in English only. The local language is Montenegrin.

Is there a dress code?

Casual and comfortable, whatever this means for you. Please bring clothes suitable for warm weather. Within the Monastery itself, please do not wear your swimwear and ensure you have a top on (it is a special place...).

What will I eat?

Meals will be cooked in the Monastery by local cooks. If you have any allergies or dietary restrictions and have forgotten to tell us by now – **please do so immediately!**

Is there wifi at the venue?

There will be internet at the venue, but as we are setting up our internet service we ask that you do not use the wifi for any activities that use a lot of bandwidth (e.g. streaming your current Netflix obsession, or downloading that three-day-long Spotify playlist you want to listen to). **Please download any large files that you want to share before coming to the Monastery.**

It is best to assume there won't be any internet at the moment you might want it the most (this probably won't happen – but again it is a Monastery!)

If you want to have a more consistent 4G internet, you might want to buy a [SIM card](#) when you reach the airport in Montenegro.
