Dear friends, we are happy to welcome you to Belgrade, we hope you will have a great conference and enjoy the city!

Important: To get updates and event information during the conference, please join the [conference Telegram channel](#), as it will become the main source of publishing information once the conference starts. Also, since the aim for the event is to be low tech and eco-friendly, please do not expect a lot of printed material.

Travel and transport around the city

[Nikola Tesla Airport in Belgrade \(BEG\)](#) is located far outside the city centre, it takes around 20-30 minutes by car to get there. **For getting a taxi, please take a taxi voucher at a small cabin within the taxi station**, after you pass the passport control, baggage claim and customs and exit the building. **The vouchers provide fixed prices for different parts of the city** - you can ask them according to your accommodation address. **Once you exit the arrivals hall, follow the signs and proceed to the taxi station. When you provide the taxi driver with the address, you also show them the voucher so you only pay the cash amount on the voucher at the end of the ride.**

There are also [buses](#) from the airport, but please be aware it might take a long time and **won't be comfortable to travel with suitcases and bags as the buses might not stop close to your accommodation.**

Public transport in Belgrade includes multiple options, such as buses, trams and trolley buses. For more information, please refer to [this Tourist Organisation of Belgrade link](#).

There are also **plenty of taxi services available**, but please note that the **majority of taxi drivers take cash only**. You can however request a vehicle with a card payment option and some taxi companies have mobile apps available. **Some of the popular options are [Naxis Taxi](#), [Lux Taxi](#), [Pink Taxi](#).**

Location

The event will take place at **KC Grad, Brace Krsmanovic 4, Belgrade**. It is a well-known cultural centre and event space, commonly used to organise exhibitions, talks, concerts and parties.

There will also be a screening of the movie "[Total Trust](#)" in the [Belgrade Youth Center](#) on Sunday 14 May at 21.45h, as part of the Beldocs Film Festival. **Please note that we have a limited amount of tickets which will be shared on a first-come-first-served basis.** You can apply for a ticket using this form: <https://crm.shareconference.net/totaltrustmovietickets>

Emergency and additional information about Belgrade and Serbia

We hope everything will be smooth, but in case there is an emergency, **please immediately contact Nevena from SHARE Foundation at +381 60 424 2282** (WhatsApp, Telegram, Signal, Viber also available).

The weather in Belgrade during May can vary from warm and sunny (20C+) to rainy and cloudy. Evenings can also be cold, so we advise you to bring a jacket and long-sleeved clothing.

The local currency is the Serbian dinar (RSD) and there are many exchange offices around the city where you can change EUR, GBP, CHF or USD. Please consult [this National Bank of Serbia link](#) for each foreign currency's official exchange rates. We don't recommend exchanging large sums of money at the airport or in hotels as the rates are usually pretty bad compared to exchange offices.

As for electrics, Serbia uses the [standard EU/European F socket](#). Water is safe to drink from the tap. If you want to get a local SIM card, you can do this at many stores operated by any of the three mobile network providers: [Yettel](#), [A1](#) or [Telekom Serbia](#). Ask for the prepaid data only plan as it will be the most effective during your stay.
